MEN: Indoor and outdoor shoes (NO NEW SHOES), socks, sweatsuit, T-shirts, knee-length shorts, towel, swimsuit, soap, sleeping bag, pillow, notebook, Bible, pen or pencil, and a cooperative spirit. Players are welcome to bring their own balls as long as they are clearly marked.

LADIES: Indoor and outdoor tennis shoes, heavy athletic socks, one-piece swimsuit, windpants (no slacks or jeans), culottes or knee-length shorts, T-shirts (NO sleeveless or tank tops), skirt for Wednesday church service, personal articles, sleeping bag, notebook, pillow, towel, pen or pencil, cooperative spirit, and Bible. All personal items must be clearly marked with camper's name.

DO NOT BRING: Radios, RVs, air conditioners, MP3s, iPods, DVD or CD players, playing cards, fireworks, knives, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products.

Medical Release Form

- Please make sure you have completed all sections of the medical release form before you send it in.
- ALL medications must be brought to camp in their original containers with instructions for dosage and times for administration. Medications must be given to the camp health supervisor to administer.
- Please attach to this form a separate piece of paper with brief explanations of any answers dealing with pre-existing injuries, other special medical conditions, or over-the-counter medication preferences. Although we do not require that a physical be mailed to us, we highly recommend that your child have a physical within the 24 months preceding sports camp to ensure his or her health and safety.
